<b>Glossary</b>	
<b>ADA Person</b>	A wide range of physical or mental impairment/disability
<b>BHCS Client</b>	A BHCS client is any individual who is assigned an LOC 1-4 while incarcerated at Santa Rita Jail.
<b>Homeless</b>	Someone is considered homeless if their housing status meets the Alameda County Health Homelessness Definition <a href="#">Click here for more information from Alameda County Health.</a>

<b>LOC</b>	Level of Care is an Alameda County Behavioral Health Department protocol. A client's LOC represents the client's current presentation and functioning. <a href="#">Click here for more information from the Behavioral Health Department.</a>
<b>Severely Mentally Ill</b>	SMI reflects that AFBH has determined that a client (any client LOC 1-4) has a qualifying SMI mental health diagnosis.
<b>Sentencing</b>	Anyone who is going to serve their sentences at Santa Rita Jail
<b>X</b>	Typically an individual in custody in another jurisdiction; but held in Santa Rita Jail for a local court case.
<b>O</b>	Uncategorized data field used in rare instances that require further reconciliation
<b>No Housing</b>	Has not been assigned a housing unit; typically a newly booked person
<b>ITR</b>	Intake Transfer and Release
<b>OPHU</b>	Out Patient Housing Unit
